Over 1 billion (1,000,000,000) people experience a disability

- But they are 2x more likely to experience inadequate health care
- 3x more likely to be denied health care
- 4x more likely to be treated badly in the health care system

















Health Care

- ½ of those with disabilities (500,000,000) cannot afford to get health care
- This can push a family into catastrophic debt or crisis



200,000,000 need glasses

Two hundred million people need glasses but do not have access to them.

















70,000,000 need a wheelchair

 Seventy million people need a wheelchair and only 10% of those who need one, have one. (7,000,000)





360,000,000 people need

- 360,000,000 people need hearing aids
