Discrimination Law

The writing of the law will start soon. It will be a complicated task. It will be finished as soon as possible.

Training will be organised in 2021 about what the new law will mean for everyone.



Employment and Equal Opportunities Service: The Tribunal

When someone has complained about discrimination the case is heard by a group of people called a Tribunal.

The people on the Tribunal will need more training about different subjects for when the new law comes in.



Speech Language and Communication Needs

A survey has been sent for people to complete. It is about people's experience when they have speech, language or communication needs.



Adult Safeguarding

The Safeguarding Board has been set up. The Board is a group of people who will make sure that there is support for people who need it. The first meeting of the Safeguarding Board will be in December.

If you need a RADAR key you can get one from Batif. Batif is next door to the Guernsey Information Centre which is closed at the moment.



Disability training was given to the Election volunteers. They were told how they could help people to vote.

The Guernsey Police and Autism Guernsey have introduced an autism passport. This will mean that people with autism can get the right help and support if they need to talk to the police.
