

Accessible Beach Guide

Bays and Beaches which are accessible for wheelchair users



This guide is intended to give information about the beaches that are accessed by slipways, and also provide information about the facilities and parking near to that beach. It is recognised that not all beaches will be accessible for everyone, so the information provided in this guide should be used to review the access according the needs of the individual.

L'Ancresse / Prembroke



Vale

Large sandy beach with adjoining car parks and slipways at either end of the beach, providing access for wheelchair users. The Pembroke slipway is steep. Accessible toilets and a kiosk are situated at the beach house cafe on the western side of the beach. A beach wheelchair is sited here. See website for booking details. **gsybeachwheelchairs.com**

La Jaonneuse

Vale



A small beach with soft sand. Accessed by a short shallow slipway. Parking is in a small car park adjacent to the slip way, or in a larger car park by the Bay apartments. The closest accessible toilet is at L'Ancresse.





Large car park, with slipway leading to hard sand on the beach. An accessible toilet, kiosk and tearoom are all nearby.

Ladies Bay

Vale



Large sandy bay, accessed by slipway from the adjoining car park. Toilets are situated near by the children's park. Please note the nearest accessible toilet is at Pembroke.





Short slipway to sandy beach. Parking and toilets are adjacent to the beach. Please note the nearest accessible toilet is at Pembroke.

Grandes Rocques (Saline Bay)



Castel

Large sandy beach, accessed by soft sand covered path with steps next to the beach kiosk, or via a steep access ramp from Saline Car Park. Accessible toilets are situated near to the kiosk.



Cobo Castel



A large sandy bay with car parks situated near to a kiosk and slipway at both the northern and southern ends of the beach. There are toilets at the southern end of the beach but please note that the nearest accessible toilet is at Vazon or Grandes Rocques.

North Cobo

Slip way has cobbles down the centre of the slipway until half way, then across the width of the slipway.

South Cobo (L'Estrainfer)

The slipway is cobbled.



Vazon Bay

Castel

Large beach, with a long shallow slipway leading to firm sand. It has a cobbled centre but the sides are level which allows access for wheelchair users. A car park is close by and an accessible parking space and accessible toilet is available adjacent to Vistas.



Vazon South (Richmond)

Slip way has cobbles down the centre of the slipway until half way, then across the width of the slipway.





Large sandy bay with a slipway at the northern end. There are two large car parks, a kiosk, a café and an accessible toilet adjacent to the carpark.

Portelet Bay






Small sandy beach with parking 100 metres from a steep cobbled slipway, providing access to the beach. A kiosk and accessible toilets are situated nearby. An accessible parking space is available near the kiosk.

Rocquaine Bay

St Peter's



Large sandy bay with access via steep slipways either end of the beach. Parking is available between the two slipways and a kiosk and toilet facilities are situated at the southern end of the beach. The nearest accessible toilet is at Portlet Bay.

St Peter Port





A sandy beach in St Peter Port, which is south of the harbour and accessible by a steep slipway at either end.

Northern Slipway

The northern slipway is most accessible, with the nearest accessible space and accisble toilet by the bus station. The southern slipway is cobbled and has drop to access the beach. Accessible parking is outside Octopus restaurant. The nearest accessible toilet is at the bus terminus.
