Heidi Soulsby, President of Health and Social Care said "We are delighted we are able to bring back those of our community who have been living off-island for several years as we have not had the facilities to care for them here. Importantly, means they can be closer to their families and be part of island life."

There are 5 assisted changing rooms, of different sizes. The wheelchair accessible changing room is shown.

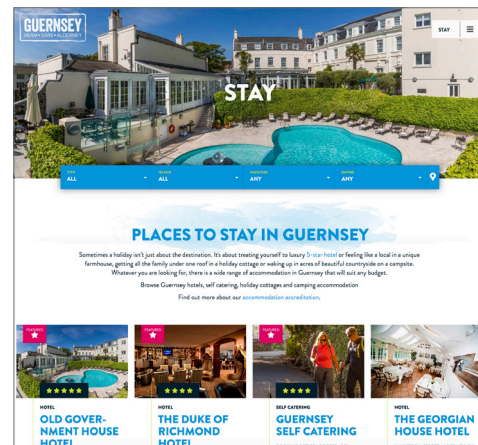


Joyous Childhood Conference
